

# HARBORD WINES

## Harbord Wines 2008 Pinot Noir – Mount Crawford, Adelaide Hills.

The Mount Crawford Pinot Noir grapes were picked at the end of February 2008. The grapes were picked at 14.0 baume and 'cold-soaked' for 8 days in small stainless vats. The Pinot Noir was then warmed to 25 degrees and an active Pinot yeast culture was added to the vat. The active fermentation lasted for 9 days, with daily hand plunging taking place to ensure maximum flavour and colour extraction. The wine was then held 'on-skins' for 7 days to extract the appealing tannins to the wine. After pressing the free-run was kept separate from the pressings fraction. Aging occurred in new and old French Oak for 4 months. A light filtration occurred prior to bottling to retain the fabulous Pinot Noir fruit flavours.
