Harbord Wines 2010 Clare Valley Riesling



The Riesling grapes for this excellent wine were harvested from the southern slopes of the family Kerkaraboo Vineyard, south-east of Clare.

Cold pressed Riesling juice was carefully fermented with an aromatic yeast and bottled early to retain freshness and pure varietal characteristics.
